What makes AHEC Scholars Programs Active?


- 1. Discipline-specific program developed and <u>implemented</u> including didactic and experiential components that address core topic areas
- 2. Cohort of health/allied health students recruited and enrolled
- 3. <u>All</u> enrolled Scholars participated in <u>interprofessional</u> field placements in <u>rural or underserved</u> communities during the academic year

 - DV-1: Ethnicity x Race
 - DV-2: Disadvantaged Background
 - DV-3: Rural Residential Background

- EXP-1: Training Site Characteristics-
 - Name, Site Type, Designated Settings
 - City, State, Zip, Zip +4 (city and state now auto-populate from Zip)
 - Added two new columns
 - Select Payment Model(s) utilized at the site (select all that apply)
 - Select whether Interprofessional Education and/or Practice is implemented at site
- EXP-2: Trainee professions/disciplines and counts for:
 - Principal Trainees (AHEC Scholars and Community-based Field Placements)
 - "Other" Interprofessional Trainees (must be >0 if site implements IP Education/Practice)
- EXP forms function the same across all program types, nothing specific to AHEC Scholars
- Both new and prior sites can be deleted from EXP-1


